When a consumer is set on a different figure, we'll quite often specify a quarter-lower veneer and invest the discount rates in good-notch, low-VOC ending.

Veneer as a sustainability multiplier

A few years back, I worked on a walnut kitchen wherein the patron needed wide, cathedral-grain panels with flawlessly aligned grain throughout a 10-foot run. Doing that in strong wooden might have required heavy boards, wasteful resawing, and quite a lot of textile paid for but in no way noticed. Veneer solved the equation.
