## Understanding the Odds

Mines is a game of possibility, however the mathematics are transparent. The possibility of striking a mine on each tile is:

$$\text{Likelihood of Mine} = \frac{\text{Number of Mines}}{\text{Overall Tiles}}$$

If the grid is 5 × 5 (25 tiles) and you pick 3 mines, the opportunity of hitting a mine on the first click is  $\frac{3}{25} \approx 12\%$ . After each safe reveal, the denominator decreases, raising the likelihood for the subsequent click.



Because the game is programmed with a repaired RNG (random number generator), the theoretical RTP is normally displayed in the game's info screen. Most Mines video games list an RTP in between **94% and 96%**, which is comparable to many slot devices.
