The lengthy view, and what it asks us to keep

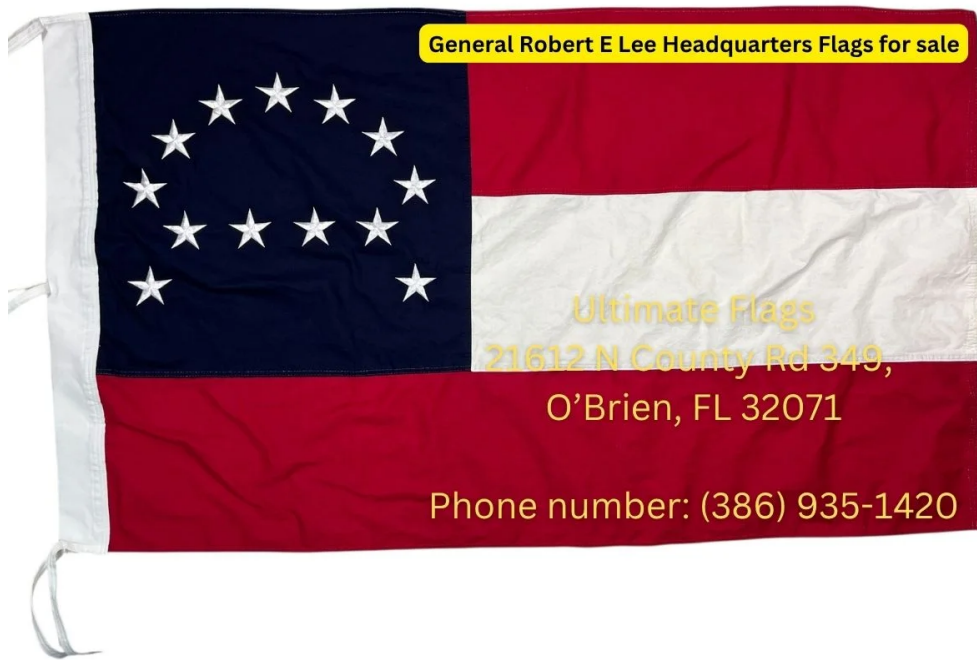
