The perimeter cabinets were painted in a comfortable gray waterborne alkyd. The island takes abuse, wipes clear, and shows no cup earrings. The painted perimeter looks hot and has survived a dozen holiday dinners with in simple terms one small chip wherein a stand mixer met a drawer front.

Then there was the small town kitchen where the owner dreamed of a deep blue, pretty much black, brush-stroked glance on custom cabinets. We used a high great oil enamel for the doorways and frames, applied by means of a continuous-handed painter. The room receives little direct solar. The leveling and depth are ridiculous within the supreme manner, and yellowing has been negligible. Right product for the accurate room.

Skip harsh abrasives. A moderate dish cleaning soap resolution and a tender fabric tackles 90 % of dust. Dry after washing other than letting water sit down on door bottoms or inside sink base frames. On clear finishes, microfiber beats paper towels, which might scratch if there is grit.
